The Aimpoint ACRO C-2 is a compact, robust, and versatile red dot sight designed for a wide range of applications, from pistols and rifles to shotguns, and like its successor, the original ACRO, the ACRO C-2 builds on its strengths and addresses some of its limitations.



The ACRO C-2 is light and compact presenting a low profile, but do not be misled by its

compactness, the C-2 is built to take anything you throw at it.



With a battery installed and mounted on the B&T mount, the ACRO C-2 weighs only 4.8 ounces. The sight and mount package measures 2.29 inches overall and two inches to the center of the aperture, and seamlessly integrates with most setups without requiring adjustments to stock height or cheek weld.

The ACRO C-2 is a model of simplicity. Its clear clearly labeled controls and bright intuitive dot make it incredibly user-friendly. With 6 daylight and 4 night vision brightness settings, the C-2 delivers superior performance under the most challenging lighting conditions.

At the range the C-2 performed superbly. Wind and elevation adjustments provide excellent audible and tactile feedback contributing to the sight's ease of use and promoting shooter confidence.





The key takeaway from the image above is not the impressive 3-shot group at 25 yards. My focus is on the precise vertical movement of the point of impact as I zeroed the sight. This demonstrates the lack of wind influence on elevation adjustments.

The Aimpoint ACRO C-2 is a testament to the brand's reputation for ruggedness and reliability. Its closed emitter design safeguards vital components, while its anodized aluminum housing ensures durability in extreme conditions. Built to withstand recoil and harsh environments, the C-2 delivers consistent performance you can count on.

Powered by a standard CR2032 battery, the ACRO C2 offers an impressive 50,000 hours of battery life at a dot brightness setting of 6. This means extended use without the hassle of frequent battery changes, and battery replacement can be done without removing the sight.

The dot remains clear and consistent across all brightness settings, making it easy to use in both bright sunlight and low-light conditions.
